We support anyone living in the East Riding regardless of gender, age, race, background, disability, sexuality, or type of relationship.

DVAP has three parts to the service

DVAP Adults Service supports anyone living with or fleeing from domestic violence and abuse, aged 16 years and over. We provide both emotional and practical support with:

- Personal safety
- Housing options
- Making your home safe and secure
- Legal options
- Welfare benefits
- Child protection issues and appropriate child related services
- Access to appropriate medical assistance.

We also offer recovery group programmes.

DVAP Children's Service supports children and young people aged 6 to 16 years old who have been affected by domestic abuse within their family or own teen relationship. We provide one-to-one tailored support based on the individual needs of each child or young person.

PODAS (Prevention of Domestic Abuse Service) provides practical and emotional support to those whose behaviour is abusive and want to change. Support will be on a one-to-one basis exploring key coping strategies for managing behaviours. We also offer a group programme for men who are at risk of or have exposed their children to domestic abuse called 'Caring Dads'.
