

- Roof Top M&E Equipment Installation commenced with crane lifts.
- The Internal concrete slabs are progressing well to all levels.
- Internal Hoist is installed to feed in the Internal Fit-Out.
- Internal fit out has also commenced and continues for Sprinklers, M&E and Internal Walls.
- The acoustic fence line is nearing completion alongside the open space corridor receiving minor remedial works.
