	Safety, Health & the Environment TSL updated the meeting that all SHE documents required to carry out the works safely were being produced, including Risk Assessments and Method Statements. 24Hr site security and Guard Dog remains operational. All the noise and vibration monitoring stations are in operation with reports being received monitoring against the baseline levels set, with no issues to date. The project initial CCS shore 41/45 was shared and received well. Fencing positioned at the South east corner of the site to be reviewed to see if any improvements can be made to allow deer to access the land parallel to the rail track.
