

THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL**ORDER UNDER SECTION 16A OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984****FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ON HIGHWAYS****NORTH FERRIBY REMEMBRANCE PARADE****NORTH FERRIBY**

On 22nd August 2025 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made a regulation under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will be operative from 10:15 hrs to 12:30 hrs on 9th November 2025. The effect of the regulation will be:-

1. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along the following roads : -

Length of road to be closed	Period of Closure
Turners Lane, North Ferriby (whole extent) Low Street (from Turners Lane to School Lane) High Street/Ferriby High Road (from Woodgates Lane to access to Tithe Farm, including slip road onto Church Road) Swanland Hill (from southern entrance to access road to junction with High Street) Church Road (including School Lane, Reading Room Yard, Church Avenue, Wilson Close and East Mount) - (from High Street to New Walk)	10:15 hrs to 12:30 hrs

2. The Order will not extend to emergency vehicles.
3. The Order shall not prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the said lengths of road.
4. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (On Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation) Order 2021 is hereby suspended for the lengths of road listed in the Schedule for the duration of this Order.
5. The Regulation may be examined during normal office hours from the date of this Notice until 9th November 2025 at Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA.
