ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847
FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ON HIGHWAYS
NORTH FERRIBY REMEMBRANCE PARADE
VARIOUS ROADS, NORTH FERRIBY

On 4th November 2021 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made a regulation under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 which will be operative from 10:15 hours to 12:30 hours on 14 November 2021. The effect of the regulation will be:-

1. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along the following lengths of road:-

<u>Length of road to be closed</u>	<u>Period of Closure</u>
Low Street – full extent	10:15 hours to 12:30 hours - these
Turners Lane – full extent	closures will operate as rolling
Church Street – full extent including the slip road extending from the west bound carriageway of Ferriby High Road into Church Road and Ferriby Road	road closures and roads will be reopened once the parade has passed consistent with
High Street / Ferriby High Road – between the junctions with Turners Lane and the access road to Tithe Farm	maintaining public safety

2. The Regulation will not extend to emergency vehicles.
3. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (On Street Parking Places)(Civil Enforcement)(Consolidation) Order 2014 is hereby suspended for the areas listed for the duration of this Order.
4. The Regulation may be examined during normal office hours from the date of this Notice until 14th November 2021, at Haltemprice Customer Services and Library, East Riding Leisure Haltemprice, 120 Springfield Way, Anlaby HU10 6QJ, and Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley HU17 9BA.
