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Our recent activities

- The superstructure phase of the project is now almost completion with remaining works predominately to the main office and continuing with active engagement from key stakeholders and the Local Council through our Monthly Community Liaison Meetings.
- The acoustic fence line is nearing completion alongside the open space corridor receiving minor remedial works.
- The Main Warehouse Ground Floor Slab including the Office will be complete before the Christmas shutdown period.
- The Main Warehouse upper floor pours continue will be complete by mid-January at which point the concrete batching plants will be decommissioned.
- Tarmac Basecourse to Main Car Park areas is now complete further eliminating the potential for mud/debris onto roads.
- The Main Car Park is now also being cleared of redundant material/debris for the Christmas Shutdown.
- Final finishes to the external hard and soft areas are due imminently. Fencing, Protection & Lining works have commenced.
- Internal fit out has also continues with Fire Protection, Sprinkler & M&E trades.
