Responding to the Threat of Travellers

The Parish Council and residents were affronted by threats from the previous owner of North Ferriby Utd FC to encourage travellers to set up on the football pitch. To make it clear, the football club area is owned by this village, having been left in trust by Anne Turner for recreational use.

The Parish Council as a corporate body is the sole trustee of the land and is answerable to the Charities Commission to ensure that the only activities carried out on the land are as per the trust deed.



Given the threat that was made, the PC took proportionate action for a short period of time to secure the playing field area, whilst maintaining pedestrian access. However, we feel on balance that the needs and convenience of the users of the area are greater than the threat and so the restrictions on access have been lifted. However, we would appreciate it if any untoward activity in the Grange Lane area could be reported to the Clerk or a Parish Councillor as soon as possible.

Commemorating Merchant Navy Day

North Ferriby will again be commemorating **Merchant Navy Day** on Monday 3rd September by flying the **Red Ensign** in the village.

The occasion honours the brave men and women that kept us afloat during both World Wars and celebrates the modern day seafarers who are responsible for 95% of UK imports. It is hoped that the Red Ensign will be flown in 800 locations across the UK in September.

Problems accessing health appointments?



MEDIBUS

Changes to local bus services have made it more difficult for residents to get to health centres, clinics and hospitals. Working with our ward councillors an extension to the **Medibus** service has been arranged. **Medibus** is a dial-a-ride facility – when you have an appointment that you need to get to either ring 03456 445 959 or email passengerbookings@eastriding.gov.uk as soon as you can to book a place on the bus. Opening hours for the call centre are 8.30am – 4.30pm Monday to Friday, excluding bank holidays.

Medibus can get patients to hospital for 8.30am appointments through to 3 pm. Later appointments in the afternoon can be booked for but there will be no return journey, so you will need to make alternative arrangements. Passenger assistants and children go FREE but the cost of the service is

Frustrated by litter on the A63 & surrounding roads?

The council would like to work with interested parties to bring those responsible for littering to account. Here is below a request from enforcement officers at East Riding Council.

Littering is a criminal offence and therefore it must be proven beyond reasonable doubt that the person or businesses is in fact the party responsible. We would therefore need witnesses who are willing to come forward to contact the council with details as to what they have witnessed including vehicles details, dates and times of any incidences of littering. This will then enable us to consider appropriate further action in an attempt to improve the situation. We very much hope that local residents are willing and able to assist us in this.

Reporting littering incidences and littering from vehicles can be done online via the eastriding.gov.uk website by searching for littering. We would urge when reporting that people do not do this anonymously as without a name to support the report we cannot take further action.
