### NORTH FERRIBY COMMEMORATES VE DAY 80th ANNIVERSARY



A week of shared celebrations to commemorate VE Day 80 was held in the village starting with a Church Service and sharing VE Day memories ahead of the 8th May. The day itself started with the raising of the VE Day flag at the War Memorial. Church bells rang in the early evening and around 200 people gathered in the Village Hall to see VE Day footage with a complimentary glass of prosecco. Many people went on to the Riverside Walkway for the beacon lighting ceremony. The Duke of Cumberland and Ferriby Social Club also joined in with Fish & Chip specials at the former, and a packed programme of events at the club.

But the absolute highlight for many was the fabulous children from North Ferriby CE Primary School entertaining the Village Hall audience with their rendition of many wartime classics, culminating in the singing of 'I Vow To Thee My Country'. The uniforms, the hair and the make-up were fabulous, and our thanks go to Mrs Spencer and staff, as well as the children, for all the hard work that went into making the event so memorable.

### FERRIBY HIGH ROAD TO CLOSE TO TRAFFIC FROM 21st JULY

The Parish Council has been informed that Ferriby High Road will be closed to all traffic from Monday 21st July through to Friday 29th August, covering the full duration of the school summer holidays.

The closure is to allow for drainage works and road resurfacing linked with the new housing estate to be carried out along with the installation of a new footpath.

We have challenged whether such an extensive closure is required, however due to the depth of the excavation and the location of an existing gas main, a full road closure is required to meet safety standards. The footpath will remain open for the duration of these works.

## WIND FARM COMMUNITY FUND ALLOCATED

Nine applications were received for the Wind Farm Community Fund having the total application value of £18,562.63, with £10,500 of funds available. All projects were supported to some extent and these were as follows

£250 to North Ferriby Hedgehog Recue to contribute towards the cost of medicine and food

£1,700 to North Ferriby Cricket Club towards the cost of a new sight screen

£250 to North Ferri-bee Friendly Village Group to contribute towards the cost of seed and equipment to create wildflower meadows in the parish

£2,420 to North Ferriby Village Hall to pay for repairs to the roof

£250 to Bird Feeding in the Enchanted Woodland to contribute towards the cost of bird seed

£1,700 to Anne Turner Memorial Allotments Committee towards the cost of installing solar panels

£500 to Ferriby Shed towards the cost of installing an accessible path from the pavilion to the new workshop.

£1,700 to North Ferriby Riding for the Disabled towards the cost of repairs to the wooden stable block.

£1,700 to Ferriby and Swanland Scout Group towards replacing the door to the Scout Headquarters
