
Opening of North Ferriby Shed

- A self-managed group. Its members decide on its activities, which could initially be simply social, developing into a range of practical workshops over time. For members who are able and wish to volunteer, to carry out small tasks in the Community.

By offering a place for people to meet, talk and make/mend/create as a group, it aims to help people gain a renewed purpose and belonging. This can help to reduce isolation and feelings of loneliness and offer a support network within the village.

Final proposals for Plot E Open Space still undecided

In March the Parish Council circulated a questionnaire looking for residents' views on what changes, if any, should be carried out on the **Open Space alongside the Long Plantation**.

Following analysis of the results (a copy is on the PC's website) members of the PC, with Ward Councillors attended a meeting with Wykeland to discuss their plans for changes to the Open Space. Wykeland has now produced a 3rd Newsletter containing their updated plan, inviting comments. Unfortunately, not all residents have received a copy of this and will therefore be unaware of its content and invitation for feedback. Copies of this newsletter are available in the library if you would like one.

Although we were assured at our meeting that residents' views from the survey would be taken into account, the PC was surprised to see that our requests do not seem to have been reflected in their revised plans, especially in relation to there still being a winding path around large bunds and a lack of additional trees alongside the wood, especially at the closest point to houses. The PC will continue to fight for our residents' wishes for this space, ie no bunds, no winding path and an increase in the number of trees.
