

## PC challenges Corby Park Parking Restrictions

The disappointment and disbelief over the length of the newly installed double yellow lines on the corner of Corby Park and Melton Road was palpable in the village. North Ferriby Parish Council therefore submitted a formal complaint to East Riding of Yorkshire Council (ERYC) for its failure to consider the comments of both the PC and the then Ward Councillors, all of whom said that the lines should extend around the inside bend on Corby Park.



ERYC has now conceded and is proposing a temporary Traffic Regulation Order to install the lines as requested, for a period of 12-18 months. This allows time to assess whether there are any adverse impacts on speed of traffic or for vehicles exiting Plantation Drive. If no issues arise, the Order would be made permanent. It is anticipated that the extended lines could be in place in around 2 months' time.

The PC has also asked that ERYC looks again at the double yellow lines at the entrance to Riverside Walkway as it considers they should extend further north towards the railway bridge than they do.

## The King's Coronation

The Coronation of King Charles III will take place on Saturday 6th May. Whilst some details of the events planned for the bank holiday weekend are still to be developed, we are delighted to be able to confirm the following events:

**Friday 5th May 7.30pm** - Village Hall will be showing '**A Royal Night Out**'

**Saturday 6th May** **The Coronation** will be shown on the big screen in the Village Hall, with food and refreshments being provided by the Parish Council.

**Sunday 7th May** 12 - 8pm Ferriby Social Club will be hosting 'Ferriby Social Car Park **Coronation Sesh**', an open picnic, with music for all ears. Street parties are also being encouraged to be held on the Sunday, and the PC website has information about the arrangements required to hold a party in your street.

**Monday 8th May** is for '**The Big Help Out**' encouraging people to take part in volunteering activities.

The King has specifically requested that there be no lighting of beacons to celebrate his Coronation, and the Parish Council will be following his wishes. However, The Ferriby Shed will be decorating Coronation Gardens and the Parish Council encourages you to get the bunting out.

The PC has agreed to install a new bench in Coronation Gardens to commemorate the event so once it is in place please take time to rest a while and to reflect on our lovely village. Please keep an eye on the notice boards and the PC website for more details on all of the above.




The Village Hall continues to offer a varied programme of events and activities – please check out its website for full details. Coming up at **Ferriby Screen** are the following Friday night films:

## Parish Council returns tax increase with thanks

Last year, the PC took the difficult decision to increase its budget by significantly more than inflation. We did this so that we had a contingency fund to allow us to pay for legal and consultancy fees to help us to protect the village. We asked you to pay just under £1 a month extra (Band D property) but promised to give it back to you this year if it was not called upon.

The PC finances are in a strong position, so we are pleased to reduce the amount we are asking you to pay by £15 for the coming year. Band D properties will therefore pay a parish council precept of £40 instead of last year's £55. We are able to do this with no resulting cut to the services we provide for North Ferriby.
