

NORTH FERRIBY WIND FARM COMMUNITY FUND REPORT – YEAR 2

At the time of opening the fund for applications in June 2019, the second payment had not been received, therefore the maximum grant was reduced from £5000 to £1000 and the left over funding from the first payment was advertised as being the size of fund available. In the end income was finally received in August 2019 and so all 4 applications considered were approved in full, with the remaining funding being available in 2020.

The fund considered 4 applications and made 4 awards. Details of the successful 2019 applications are shown below.

NORTH FERRIBY VILLAGE HALL

Project: Repairs to the front of the Village Hall

TOTAL PROJECT COST £1,350

GRANT AWARDED £1,000

This project involved repairing the front exterior decoration of the Village Hall. Repairs were made to the render, woodwork and brickwork on the building to improve the appearance and reduce further deterioration.

NORTH FERRIBY PRIMARY SCHOOL

Project: Outdoor learning for all

TOTAL PROJECT COST £15,200

GRANT AWARDED £1,000

This project will create an outdoor environment on the KS1 site that fosters creativity, thinking skills, risk taking and a love of the outdoors.

NORTH FERRIBY-LE PELLERIN TWINNING ORGANISATION

Project: Afternoon Tea with our French Twinning Visitors

TOTAL PROJECT COST £1,130

GRANT AWARDED £550

This grant will contribute to the hosting of a tea party on 21st May 2020 for around 40 visitors from Le Pellerin and open to all villagers free of charge.

ROTARY CLUB OF HUMBERSIDE

Project: Senior Citizen's Tea Party

TOTAL PROJECT COST £400

GRANT AWARDED £100

This project involved part funding the Senior Citizen's Tea Party which is held annually at the Parish Hall. The funding contributes to the room hire and catering and enables 60 selected individuals to enjoy an afternoon of entertainment provided by North Ferriby Primary School Choir.
