NORTH FERRIBY WIND FARM COMMUNITY FUND REPORT – YEAR 4

The 3rd payment was received in August 2020 and due to the fact that the previous round of grants had only been approved in July 2020, it was agreed that the fund would be advertised at the end of 2020, with the grants being awarded in February 2021. Inflation increased the payment to £8,091.11.

The fund considered 4 applications and made 4 awards. Details of the successful 2021 applications are shown below.

NORTH FERRIBY VILLAGE HALL

Project: Replacement Boiler

TOTAL PROJECT COST £5,940

GRANT AWARDED £2,372

This project is to replace the boiler that will heat the main hall, the bar, the main stage and the Green Room.

NORTH FERRIBY CRICKET CLUB

Project: Upgrade to Training Facility

TOTAL PROJECT COST £2,762

GRANT AWARDED £2,372

This project will improve the training nets by extending and providing a new artificial cricket pitch and providing new nets .

FERRIBY SOCIAL CLUB

Project: Upgrade to heating system

TOTAL PROJECT COST £7,300

GRANT AWARDED £2,372

This project involves changing the heating system to ensure a warm and hospitable environment.

MEN IN SHEDS

Project: Establish a Ferriby Shed

TOTAL PROJECT COST - Unknown

GRANT AWARDED £1,000

There has been a lot of interest shown in setting up a Men in Sheds group for Ferriby. At the time of the grant process the group had not been constituted, but the Parish Council agreed to set aside funds to enable the group to be started in the future. Payment will be held until the group is formed.
