NORTH FERRIBY WIND FARM COMMUNITY FUND REPORT – YEAR 6

The 5th payment was received in September 2022. The fund was advertised at the end of 2022, with the grants being awarded in February 2023. Inflation increased the payment to £8,543.27.

The fund's popularity continues to grow and a total of 10 applications were received with the requests totalling around two and a half times the value of the fund. Of the 10 applications considered, 9 awards were made. Details of the successful 2023 applications are shown below.

NORTH FERRIBY GARDENERS' CLUB

Project: Hosting the North Ferriby Village Show

The Village Show has not been held for the last 3 years due to the pandemic, therefore this funding will allow the Gardeners' Club to establish the event anew.

NORTH FERRIBY VILLAGE HALL

Project: Repair and Refurbish Exterior Wall

TOTAL PROJECT COST £5,920

GRANT AWARDED £3,800

This project focuses on improvements to the exterior wall of the south wall and west facing gable end to ensure the integrity of the building.

NORTH FERRIBY FOOTBALL CLUB

Project: Installation of electric radiators

GRANT AWARDED £754

This project enables the purchase of a new line marking machine and drag brush for use on the two playing field mini soccer pitches and the school youth pitch.

There is insufficient space in the Paviliion for Men in Sheds group to carry out all its desired activities. The grant awarded is to provide funding for a larger project to create a dedicated building for a workshop.
