- 25. CLERK'S REPORT
 - **25.1.** The clerk reported that it had not been possible to arrange a meeting with the owner of the sluice yet but that it was hoped this would happen in the new year. It was also noted that following communication from the Highways Department at ERYC, it had been agreed that the memorial tree planted on New Walk could remain in place, along with its structure.
 - 25.2. The current financial report was reviewed. No concerns were raised.

26. OTHER MATTERS

- **26.1. War Memorial** Following correspondence from a resident about the maintenance arrangements for the War Memorial, it was agreed that SJK Garden Services would be requested to add the site to his monthly routine again and that the posts and chains will be repainted in the summer. Cllr Dennett will write to the resident to explain the actions taken.
- **26.2. Dog Fouling** A further complaint about the level of dog fouling along with a suggestion for a poster has been received. It was agreed that the poster would be used in the next newsletter and it would also be sent to the About Ferriby team as this would be published sooner. The clerk will also contact the Dog Wardens at ERYC to ask for advice and patrols in the village, especially on Station Road.
- **26.3. Mires Beck** The report from the site visit was noted and it was agreed that the suggestions made should be followed up in the spring. The information about the copse in the Allotment will be shared with the Allotment Committee and the immediate focus will be to enhance the Enchanted Woodland area of the Riverside Walkway. It was agreed that the proposal to wok with Mires Beck to develop a long term management plan for the Riverside Walkway area should be pursued.
