- 25. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs Blogg, Holborn & Knight submitted apologies
- 26. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** - Declarations are noted at the appropriate minute.
- 27. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 18 AUGUST 2021 - Resolved** – that the minutes be accepted as an accurate record and were signed by the acting Chairman.
- 28. PUBLIC FORUM** – There was no public speaking
- 29. PARK WARDEN’S REPORT** – The Park Warden reported that there had been damage to one of the railings on the skate park ramps. It was agreed that the damaged railing should be removed and Cllr Wood would investigate potential contractors to carry out a repair. It was also noted that the Quarterly inspection had been carried out.
- 30. CLERK’S REPORT**
- 30.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that there had been two complaints received. The first was about small children running around in the skate park and the second was regarding a fall due to a failure in the wet pour surface. The wet pour surface was repaired the following day. The CCTV power supply needs a repair to reduce the power interruptions and it was agreed that Lytec should carry this out at a cost of £370 + VAT. Finally it was agreed that the Annual Inspection would be arranged with The Play Inspection Company and that the risk assessment for the playing fields would be reviewed by Cllrs Abraham and Wood.
- 30.2.** The financial position of the Playing Field Committee was noted. No concerns were raised.
- 31. OTHER MATTERS**
- 31.1. Quarterly Inspection** – The report was reviewed, and it was agreed that up to £200 should be spent on wet pour material and £80 on filler for the skate park.
- 31.2. Public Spaces Protection Orders** – It was noted that the PSPO will be reviewed in 2022 and it was agreed that consideration should be given to applying for a dog exclusion zone on the playing fields.
- 31.3. Grounds Maintenance** – It was agreed that the Clerk would request quotations for 2022/23 from the existing suppliers to be reviewed at the next meeting.
- 31.4.** Due to the limited attendance, it was agreed to postpone discussions about 2022 budget planning until Octobers’ meeting.
