- 9. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** - Councillors Black, Dennett and Richardson submitted apologies.

- 13. TO RECEIVE THE CLERK'S REPORT**
 - 13.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that there had been further sightings of motorbikes on the Riverside Walkway, but that these had been reported to the Police. The matter of new litter bins on the Riverside Walkway is still being discussed with ERYC, and following a suggestion it was agreed that up to £100 would be spent on litter picker hoops to help those who volunteer.

 - 14.2. Coronation Gardens Wall** - The Clerk has arranged meetings with 3 local builders to discuss the repairs to the wall, but as yet has not received any quotations. It was agreed that in the interest of time the decision as to which quotation would be accepted would be taken at the Parish Council meeting on 28 June.
 - 14.3. Village Task Force Walkabout** - The list of items that has been compiled so far for the Village Task Force visit on 7th July was reviewed. It will be circulated before the visit.
