- 33. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs Mabbett, Richardson and Wood submitted apologies.
- 34. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** – There were no declarations.
- 35. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 27 FEBRUARY 2023 - Resolved** – that the minutes be approved as a correct record subject to a spelling correction and were signed by the Chairman.
- 36. PUBLIC FORUM** - There was no public speaking.
- 37. CLERK'S REPORT**

- 37.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that there had been an incident of motorbikes on the Riverside Walkway and an issue of wildlife crime, both of which had been reported to the police. Following correspondence from Ward Councillor Abraham, it was agreed that both Cllr Dennett and Black would meet with an officer from ERYC to discuss replanting trees along New Walk. It was also noted that the work to the bus stop on Corby Park was nearly complete.
- 37.2.** The year-end financial report was reviewed. No concerns were raised.

38. OTHER MATTERS

- 38.1. Humber Road Car Park** - It was noted that meeting with the police and residents about the antisocial behaviour at the car park had been very successful. It was agreed that a letter would be sent to all affected residents and the content was agreed.
- 38.2. Coronation** – It was agreed that up to £200 would be spent on new plants for Coronation Gardens and that they would be planted before 6th May. It was noted that the clerk had so far been unable to get any quotations to install a new plinth, but it was agreed that if possible the work should be carried out before the Coronation and so a maximum expenditure was agreed.
- 38.3. Dog Fouling** - It was agreed that a CCTV camera and new signs should be purchased to deter dog fouling on the Riverside Walkway
- 38.4. Community Safety Fund** – It was agreed that an application should be made to this fund to cover any improvements required to reduce antisocial behaviour at the Humber Road car park.
- 38.5. Village Taskforce Walkabout** – It was noted that the next walkabout is planned for 1 June and it was agreed that Cllrs Black, Blogg and Dennett would attend along with the clerk.
- 38.6. Village Walk** – It was agreed that the date of the Village Walk would be changed to Tuesday 25th April, and would start at 9am at the Riverside Walkway.
