19. **CLERK'S REPORT**
  - 19.1. **Monthly Report** – The Clerk gave the committee a report about recent correspondence with residents.

20. **OTHER MATTERS**
  - 20.1. **Blaskett Pond Gate** – It was noted that the cost to replace the Blaskett Pond gate was £820 + VAT and that this work is being arranged by the farm.
  - 20.2. **The Triangle** – It was noted that ERYC have agreed to delay the first cut of The Triangle until the beginning of July as long as a 2m strip closest to the edge of the road is cut to maintain visibility. It was agreed that this was a good solution and can be reviewed again next year.
  - 20.3. **Coronation Gardens** – The Knit and Natter group have offered to produce a display in Coronation Gardens in February next year and this was approved.
  - 20.4. **Heritage Open Day** – The plans for the events to be held on the Riverside Walkway on 16<sup>th</sup> September as part of the Heritage Open Day were discussed.
  - 20.5. **Village Walkabout** – It was agreed that the Village Walkabout would review the assets in the village and would be carried out in two groups looking at different areas.
