- 59. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllr Knight & D.Wyndham (Cricket) submitted apologies.
- 60. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** - Cllrs Blogg and Wood declared an interest as members of the Bowls Club and D.Morgan declared an interest as a member of the Ferriby Shed
- 61. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 8 MARCH 2023 - Resolved** – that the minutes be accepted as an accurate record and were signed by the Chairman.
- 62. PUBLIC FORUM** – There was no public speaking
- 63. PARK WARDEN’S REPORT** – The Park Warden reported that there has been damage done to a couple of repaired patches of the wet pour near the multiplay unit. These areas will be repaired as soon as the weather conditions are favourable. It was also noted that some graffiti had been added to a wall in the skate park but that this would be covered over.
- 64. CLERK’S REPORT**
- 64.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that since the last meeting the following actions had been completed, the wheelchair ramp had been delivered to the pavilion, the pavilion roof had been repaired and the request to use forms had been sent out. It was noted that the water price had been increased by 8% and the planning application for Ferriby Shed had been submitted. Finally it was agreed that the inclusion of additional open space next to the Playing Fields as part of the FER-B development site in the submission documents for the Local Plan Update was an excellent result and thanks were expressed to all parties who had helped lobby for this.
- 64.2.** The financial position of the Playing Field Committee was noted. No concerns were raised.
- 65. OTHER MATTERS**
- 65.1. Bowl’s Club** – Cllrs Blogg and Wood explained that the bowls pavilion had suffered rain damage to the flooring and it was agreed by the other members of the committee that the repairs costing around £300 would be paid for by the Playing Field Committee. Repairs to the shed roofs will also be carried out in the next month with the help from the Shedders, and materials for this work have already been purchased.
- 65.2. Cricket Club** – It was agreed that the showers should be repaired before the start of the cricket season and that the Playing Field Committee would get quotations for a new water heater to provide running hot water in the kitchen.
- 65.3. Pavilion** – It was agreed that two replacement LED light fittings would be fitted in the store room.
