- 55.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported the new flags had been purchased. It was also noted that a resident had complained about the overgrown hedge at the bottom of Swanland Hill and this had been cut back by ERYC.

- 56. OTHER MATTERS**
- 56.1. Riverside Walkway** – It was noted that Ferriby Fencing had been awarded the work of removing the sycamore trees from the copse on the Riverside Walkway at a cost of £600 + VAT.
- 56.2. Network Rail’s Biodiversity survey** – It was decided that the survey should be completed and the responses were agreed.
- 56.3. Trees** – It was noted that a new TPO is being created on Danby Vale. Also, following the successful visit of the Tree officer, which identified up to 70 potential locations for new trees on the verges, it was reported that a meeting had been arranged with the Humber Forest team at ERYC to progress these plans and an update would be given at the next meeting.
- 56.4. Coronation Gardens** – It was agreed that new plants should be purchased with a value up to £100 and planting should be done before the Open Gardens event on 16th June.
- 56.5. Risk Assessment** – The updated risk assessment following the Village Walk was reviewed and approved.
