13. **CLERK’S REPORT**
  - 13.1. **Monthly Report** – The Clerk updated the committee with correspondence from a resident.
  - 13.2. The current financial position was reviewed. No concerns were raised.
14. **OTHER MATTERS**
  - 14.1. **The Triangle** – The wording of a survey for the residents overlooking The Triangle was agreed and will be circulated by the Clerk.  
*Cllr J.Abraham declared a non-pecuniary interest.*
  - 14.2. **Trees** – The correspondence from the ERYC tree officer giving the Environment Committee permission to plant trees in the verges at the locations agreed during the visit in April was noted and the Clerk shared information gained in recent training. It was agreed that Barnes Associates would be contacted to provide a list of suitable trees at the various locations and the plans would be publicised in the next newsletter.
  - 14.3. **Riverside Walkway** – Following the successful site visit on 27<sup>th</sup> June, the RSPCA Wildlife Group have suggested holding a public engagement day on the Riverside Walkway on 24<sup>th</sup> August. This was approved by the committee on the basis that it will be insured by the RSPCA.
  - 14.4. **Local Nature Recovery Strategy** – It was agreed to contact the LNRS team and raise the importance of the pond by the St Modwen mound being regularly used by deer and to note that it has disappeared during the construction work on Amazon site. It was also agreed that it would be recommended to the Parish Council that this matter is raised at the Amazon Liaison meeting.
