- 60. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs Blogg, Holborn, Knight & Shaikh and D.Wyndham (Cricket Club) submitted apologies.
- 61. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** – Cllr Wood declared an interest as a member of the Bowls Club and D.Morgan declared an interest as a member of the Ferriby Shed.
- 62. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 14 FEBRUARY 2024 - Resolved** – that the minutes be accepted as an accurate record and were signed by the Chairman.
- 63. PUBLIC FORUM** – There was no public speaking.
- 64. PARK WARDEN’S REPORT** – The Park Warden reported that there had been an increase in litter in the park. It was also noted that the wires at the base of the tennis court fencing had broken due to the fencing being frequently hit by footballs. It was agreed that the Park Warden would be asked to make repairs.
- 65. CLERK’S REPORT**
- 65.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that the repairs to the multiplay equipment had been carried out and that the wildflower seeds had been sewn at the entrance to Grange Lane. It was agreed that the damaged tennis court net should be replaced at a cost of £104 + delivery. Concerns from the cricket club regarding overuse of specific areas of the playing field by football training were discussed and it was agreed that the clerk would contact users and ask them to train on the opposite side of the field. It was noted that both the water supply to the changing rooms and the Bowls Pavilion would be switched on and legionella checks would be resumed. Finally the response from the Football Club regarding the Ferriby Festival was discussed and it was agreed that additional controls would be requested.
- 65.2.** The financial position of the Playing Field Committee was noted. No concerns were raised.
- 66. OTHER MATTERS**
- 66.1. Ferriby Shed** – Following a successful wind farm grant the location of the new accessible path to the workshop was discussed and agreed, subject to agreement with the Cricket Club. It was agreed that D. Morgan would meet with the Cricket Club and confirm the outcome to the Clerk.
- 66.2. ERYC Playing Pitch Strategy 2024-2029** – It was noted that the Clerk had completed the survey sent by ERYC to ensure that the facilities of the playing field were accurately reflected within the update of this Strategy document.
- 66.3. Request to Use Form 2024** – It was agreed that the form should be updated to remove the mention of Covid-19, and it should be sent out to all users.
