- **44.7. Yorkshire Water** The correspondence from Yorkshire Water stating that they are not responsible for the ditch flooding was noted.
- **44.8. Rock Armour and Sluice Gate** The information circulated before the meeting was discussed, and it was agreed that a recommendation would be made to the full PC meeting later that before carrying out any repairs to the sluice gate and rock armour the legal team at ERYC should be contacted to ensure any solution is compatible with the management agreement for Ings Fields.
