 - 7.1. Monthly Report The Clerk reported that the work to the bus stop roof had been completed. It was also noted that the LNRS Consultation had been completed following the 1-2-1 meeting, the tree work on T9 had been scheduled with Ferriby Fencing at a cost of £600 and that the 'No Fire' sign had been installed on the Riverside Walkway.

- **8.3. Station Walk and Station Adoption** The outcome of the Community Rail Walk between Hessle and Ferriby was noted. It was also noted the those who had expressed interest in the Station Adoption were being invited to a kick-off meeting on Sat 19th July at 10am.
- **8.4. Blasket Pond** Information about the new fencing and hedging around Blasket Pond was noted. It was also agreed that the Title Plans for the area would be retrieved from Land Registry at a cost of £11.
