It was also agreed that a structural engineer should be appointed to look into the stability of the structure and that the Clerk could approve the work if £500 or less.
- **15.3. Bus Stops** It was agreed that Ferriby Shed would be asked to sand and varnish the Corby Park bus stop at a cost of f140.
- **15.4. Hosepipe Ban** It was agreed that Coronation Gardens would continue to be watered but via watering cans.
- **15.5. Riverside Walkway** The correspondence regarding establishing a memorial on the Riverside Walkway was discussed and the response agreed.
- **15.6. Riverside Walkway** The Committee discussed different activities to mark the 40th Anniversary of the Riverside Walkway, and it was agreed that a new sign should be created for the entrance to the Riverside Walkway.
- **15.7. Blasket Pond** The information from the land registry was noted. It was agreed to contact the Conservation Officer at ERYC to see if wildlife can be given access to the pond following the installation of new fencing around the pond.
