- 54. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs Blogg and Holborn submitted apologies.
- 55. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** – D. Morgan declared an interest as a member of Ferriby Shed and D.Wyndham declared an interest as a member of the Cricket Club.
- 56. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 15 JANUARY 2026 – Resolved** – that the minutes be accepted as an accurate record and were signed by the Chairman.
- 57. PUBLIC FORUM** – There was no public speaking
- 58. PARK WARDEN’S REPORT** – The Park Warden reported that there were no new issues to raise.
- 59. CLERK’S REPORT**
- 59.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that the electricity tariff had been changed and the direct debit set up. It was noted that both the PAT testing and the CCTV annual inspection have been carried out with no issues to report.
- 59.2.** The financial position of the Playing Field Committee was noted and no concerns were raised.
- 60. OTHER MATTERS**
- 60.1. Survey of Poplar Trees** – The detailed survey of the Poplar Trees was reviewed, and it was agreed that the Clerk would get prices to pollard the trees.
- 60.2. Annual Play Inspection Report** – The annual report was reviewed in detail. It was noted that the overall risk rating had not changed, but that the number of issues had decreased. The points requiring action were agreed.
- 60.3. Cricket Club** – An update was given and it was noted that repairs were being made to the older sight screen, and that in order to get power to the Score Hut, the fuse board in the pavilion needs to be upgraded. This is a project due for completion in the next financial year. A discussion was also had about the condition of the grass in front of the pavilion that is being damaged by football users. Cllr M.Abraham explained his conversation with a new user and it was agreed that the Clerk should review the CCTV to explore if there are further users in this area.
- 60.4. Know Your North Ferriby Event** – It was agreed that D.Morgan would be able to help at the event, and the items for the display were agreed.
