- 45.2. Memorial Plaque** – The request for a Memorial Plaque to be installed on a bench at the far end of the Riverside Walkway was approved and the Clerk will work with the family to ensure it is installed.

- 45.4. 40th Anniversary of the Riverside Walkway** – The Clerk shared the information that she had found in the Archives, and the other opportunities to find more information were discussed. The formatting of the competition that will be launched to help find to native trees that were planted to mark the Millenium was agreed. Finally it was agreed that a logo should be created for the project, and the Clerk will try to find help to do this.
