61. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs M.Abraham, Blogg and Holborn submitted apologies
62. **DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** – D. Morgan declared an interest as a member of Ferriby Shed and D.Wyndham declared an interest as a member of the Cricket Club.
63. **MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 11 FEBRUARY 2026 – Resolved** – that the minutes be accepted as an accurate record and were signed by the Vice Chairman.
64. **PUBLIC FORUM** – There was no public speaking
65. **PARK WARDEN'S REPORT** – The Park Warden reported that significant damage had occurred to the wet pour under the multiplay unit and lots of mud from football boots had been evident. The Park Warden was able to carry out repairs 2 days later, but the park had to be closed for the day. The following week, there was significant debris that had to be cleared from the Skate Park. It was also noted that the Park Warden is now available to litter pick on a Wednesday, and it was agreed that he should return to his original working pattern.
66. **CLERK'S REPORT**
  - 66.1. **Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that the mechanism had been replaced in the entrance gate and that £97.33 + VAT had been spent buying a wet pour repair kit. It was also noted that the CCTV had been reviewed twice to investigate the incidents reported by the Park Warden. Notices have been installed requesting that football boots are not worn in the play area and the junior football managers have been contacted about this.
  - 66.2. The financial position of the Playing Field Committee was discussed, and it was agreed that the payment for the Tree Survey would be claimed back from the reserves held for tree work.
67. **OTHER MATTERS**
  - 67.1. **Water** – It was agreed that the water supply to the Changing Rooms would be turned on at the beginning of April.
  - 67.2. **Pavilion toilet** – It was noted that there appears to be a leak in the wall behind the sink in the Pavilion toilet. The clerk will see if she can find out where the pipework is and will contact a plumber to investigate the matter.
  - 67.3. **Request to Use Form 2026** – It was agreed that the form should be sent out to all existing and new users, with invoices being raised where appropriate. In light of the increased use, it was agreed that if there was an excess demand for the playing field, the following priority would be applied to the requestors, cricket use would come first, then community groups and finally profit-making organisations.
  - 67.4. **Play Area Inspection Training** – It was agreed that D. Morgan would attend the training event on 7<sup>th</sup> July at a cost of £110+VAT.
  - 67.5. **Know Your North Ferriby** – The output of ideas for different play equipment which was collected at the event was reviewed and will be considered in the scoping process for the project to install new play equipment.
