- 34. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs Dennett and Holborn submitted apologies
- 35. DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** – Declarations are recorded at the appropriate minute.
- 36. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 24 NOVEMBER 2025 – Resolved** – that the minutes be approved as a correct record and signed by the Vice Chairman.
- 37. PUBLIC FORUM** - There was no public speaking
- 38. CLERK’S REPORT**
- 38.1. Monthly Report** – The Clerk informed the committee that the new notice board in Coronation Gardens had been installed. It was noted that the clerk had authorised for the hedge along the track into the Riverside Walkway be cut at a cost of £110 +VAT. It was agreed that ERYC Highways would be contacted regarding cars parking on the verge near the restaurant to see if bollards could be installed, and it was noted that the new trees planted on the verge at the top of Corby Park had been moved. Finally arrangements for the Know Your North Ferriby event were discussed, and it was agreed that Cllr Black would look after the table.
- 38.2.** The current financial position was reviewed. No concerns were raised.
- 39. OTHER MATTERS**
- 39.1. New Verge Trees** – It was noted that it was not possible to plant a tree on Ings Lane due to the ground conditions and instead, that tree had been planted in The Triangle. It was also noted that due to the cost, a holly tree had not been planted in The Triangle. Points raised by residents were also discussed.
- 39.2. Rural Crime** – Due to recent reports of deer poaching on the local Facebook page, it was agreed that the police should be asked to provide an update.
- 39.3. The Triangle** – Complaints were noted regarding the condition that The Triangle has been left in since it was used as a storage area, together with an acknowledgment of recent works that have been undertaken to resolve some of the issues.  
*Cllr J.Abraham declared an interest in this item*
- 39.4. Grit Bin** – It was agreed that the request for a grit bin would be refused, but that the information regarding the need for gritting around the Village Hall would be shared with the Village Hall Management Committee.
- 39.5. Station Adoption** – It was noted that the forms for the Station Adoption had been received and processed and that the next stage was to arrange a safety briefing for those interested in getting involved with the project.
- 39.6. 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Riverside Walkway** – The different ideas to mark the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Riverside Walkway were discussed, and it was agreed that holding some events on the area during the summer of 2027 should also be included. It was noted that the school are happy to be involved with the project.
