68. **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** – Cllrs Holborn and Knight and D.Morgan (Ferriby Shed) submitted apologies
69. **DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY OR NON-PECUNIARY INTEREST** – There were none.
70. **MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 11 MARCH 2026 – Resolved** – that the minutes be accepted as an accurate record and were signed by the Chairman.
71. **PUBLIC FORUM** – There was no public speaking
72. **PARK WARDEN’S REPORT** – The Park Warden reported that there had been some damage to the edge of the field due to someone attempting to dig a hole. This area has been refilled and hopefully grass will regrow soon.
73. **CLERK’S REPORT**
- 73.1. **Monthly Report** – The Clerk reported that the grassed parking area had been opened and that the water had been turned on to the Changing Rooms. The insurance level for the CCTV system has been reviewed and is acceptable. The approach from Ferriby Shed and YPD to use different parts of the Bowls area was discussed, but it was noted that the final decision will be taken by the Trustee.
- 73.2. The financial position of the Playing Field Committee was noted. It was agreed that Everyday Fitness will be permitted to make contributions towards the use of the playing fields on a monthly basis as and when it is used.
74. **OTHER MATTERS**
- 74.1. **CCTV Policy** – Both the CCTV Data Protection Policy and Privacy Impact Assessment were reviewed and approved.
- 74.2. **Change of meeting dates** – Due to the unavailability of the Clerk, it was agreed that the July meeting date would be changed to 15th July and the September meeting date to the 23rd September, but consideration would also be made to holding a meeting in August dependant on the matters needing to be discussed.
- 74.3. **Pavilion toilet** – After further investigation it appears that the damp in the Pavilion toilet is due to overspill from the sink rather than a leak behind the wall as previously thought.
- 74.4. **Playground Design** – The information from the ‘Tweens and Teens Play’ webinar was discussed and it was agreed that it was very helpful when considering the new equipment which could be placed in the Park. It was agreed that the July meeting should start in the Play Park so that the Committee could discuss the opportunities and start to scope out the project to install new play equipment. It was also agreed that the Clerk and Cllr M.Abraham would attend the Project Management training on offer from YLCA.
