- 29. WARD COUNCILLOR'S REPORT** – Ward Cllr Corless gave an update on the issues that she was currently dealing with. She also reported that significant changes are being made by Government to the Planning process, which will prevent applications being called in to committee from 31st October 2026. Instead there will be rules which govern when decisions are made by officers and when they are made by the ERYC Strategic Planning Committee.
- 30. CLERK'S REPORT** – The Clerk reported that the posts had been installed on the verge opposite Coronation Gardens and that the insurance policy had been renewed for 3 years. An update was also given about recent correspondence with residents. Finally, it was confirmed that a meeting had been arranged with Beal Homes on 23rd June to discuss the plans for the footpath linking the new housing to the village and improvements to the Grange Lane car park.

- 33.1. Council Vacancy** – It was noted that Cllr Holborn had vacated his seat and that ERYC Electoral Services had been notified of the vacancy. It was agreed that the Parish Council would write and thank Cllr Holborn for his service. The Council also reviewed its Co-Option Policy and it was agreed that should co-option be allowed, Councillors J.Abraham, Dennett, Hookem and Knight would form the Appointments Committee and dates for the advertisement were agreed.

It was also agreed to remove the home addresses from the website page and to replace them with email addresses instead.
- 33.3. **Ferriby High Road** – The informal consultation document for reducing the speed limit on Ferriby High Road was reviewed and approved.
- 33.4. **Traffic Management** – The outcome of the meeting with the Traffic Management Team was discussed. The priority areas requiring double yellow lines were agreed and it was decided that consideration for creating an improved disabled access to the Village Hall would be discussed at a future meeting.

- 33.6. **Letter from Anlaby PC** – The Council decided that due to the good relationship with the police and the CCTV in operation at the park, it did not wish to join the initiative being proposed by Anlaby PC regarding Anti-Social Behaviour.
